## Organisation and conditions for the pedagogical process and operation at the STU Faculty of Materials Science and Technology in Trnava for winter semester of 2020/2021 academic year

The Dean's Regulation No. 9/2020-UD modifies the organisation and conditions for the pedagogical process and operation at the STU Faculty of Materials Science and Technology in Trnava (hereinafter only as STU MTF) in compliance with the STU Rector's Directive No. 7/2020, issued on 29 Sep. 2020.

The Regulation is binding for all STU MTF employees and students. Starting from 5 Oct. 2020, the Regulation determines the following:

- 1. All educational activities of the bachelor and master study programmes are executed online.
- 2. In case of the students in the last year of the master study, and being approved by the Head of the related Institute, it is possible to carry out the individual operations in the laboratories, while the number of persons in the laboratory is subject to the current measures issued by the Public Health Authority of the Slovak Republic (UVZ SR), or subject to the regional public health authority.
- 3. The education of doctoral study programmes is executed on a regular basis as usual.
- 4. The educational activities acc. to 1 of the Regulation are executed in compliance with the current timetable (lectures, exercises, seminars, and consultations), via GSuite or Microsoft Teams platforms. Teachers of related subjects are responsible for the teaching scope and quality. The continuous supervision in the field is executed by the teachers' direct superior.
- 5. The Head of the Institute, where the educational activities are carried out, will appoint the employee, who will coordinate the online education at the workplace in question, and will be responsible for the regulation and coordination of the other Institute's employees in the field of online education. The Head of the Institute will inform Assoc. Prof. Roman Čička, the STU MTF Vice-Dean for Education, who will be the main Faculty coordinator for online education.
- 6. All relevant measures stated in the Dean's regulation No. 6/2020 stay in force.

Regulation comes into force and efficiency by the date of its making public.
